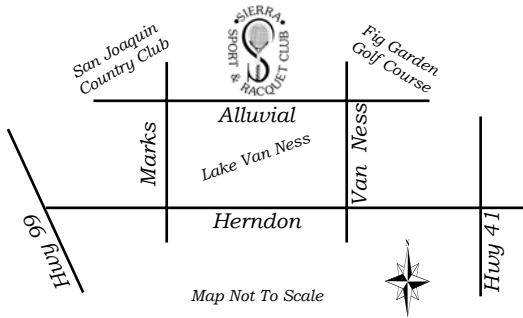

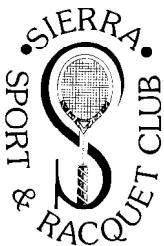

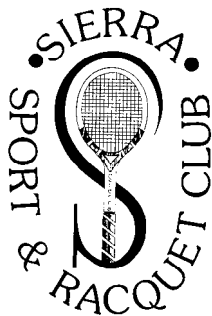

Rules & Information

- You must be a CCTA member to play.
- Submit the upper two portions of this entry form and retain the bottom portion for your records.
- There will be a one time charge of \$10 to all Non-CCTA Members payable to the CCTA at the tournament desk before play begins.
- **Entry fees are \$35.00 for singles and \$50.00 for doubles. If the tournament director can put you in after the deadline there will be a \$15 charge.**
- Partner's name must be included on entry form in designated space (no "and partner" entries).
- No refunds after the draw is complete.
- Entry fee must accompany all entry forms. No pay, no play.
- No phone or fax entries will be accepted.
- Players may enter three events...one singles and two doubles. However, one doubles must be mixed.. Entries must be at same rating level.
- Draws will be posted at Sierra Sport & Racquet Club, The Stringer and the CCTA website at centralvalleytennis.org September 1st. It is the players responsibility to check for their starting times. Absolutely NO starting times or other draw information will be given over the phone.
- **Juniors 15 and over may play in events 4.5 and above only.**
- Please report to the tournament desk at least 15 minutes before your first match. 15 minute default rule will be enforced.
- All Club & USTA rules will govern play.
- Proper tennis attire must be worn (no tank tops for men or cut-off shirts) NO running shoes or black soled shoes!!!
- All matches will be best 2 out of 3 sets, regular scoring, 12-point tiebreaker at six all (no ad scoring may be used in early rounds).
- Collegiate and junior players are welcome to play but may not accept prize money due to NCAA rules and amateur status.
- Club facilities are available for MEMBERS ONLY.
